Mr. Ilir Kadiu graduated as “Lawyer” in 1999 from the Faculty of Law, University of Tirana. In 2011 he graduated in “Master of Administrative Law” from the Faculty of Law at the European University of Tirana. In 2013, Ministry of Finance awarded him with the title “Auditor in the public sector”.

After graduation, he worked as a legal coordinator for projects of international organizations funded by UNHCR, ICMC and USAID.

In 2006 he worked as a Lawyer in the Albanian Supreme Audit in the Legal and Quality Control Department. He holds 5 years of experience in the Department of Internal Administrative Audit and Anti-Corruption in the Prime Ministry Office.
