

Periodic data of the Special Appeal Chamber on the registered cases and rendered decisions

The Special Appeal Chamber continues to exercise its function in the re-evaluation process of judges and prosecutors, following the lodging of appeals by the assessees or the Public Commissioner against the decisions of the Independent Qualification Commission.

Up to June 30, 2024, the Special Appeal Chamber has announced and delivered 259 decisions corresponding to the Re-evaluation Jurisdiction, of which 12 decisions were announced and delivered in 2018, 34 decisions were announced and delivered during 2019, 42 decisions were announced and delivered during 2020, 38 decisions were announced and delivered during 2021, 49 decisions were announced and delivered during 2022, 55 decisions were announced and delivered during 2023 and 29 decisions have been delivered until June 30, 2024.

Up to June 30, 2024, the Special Appeal Chamber has registered 384 cases corresponding to the re-evaluation jurisdiction, of which 40 cases have been registered during 2018, 62 cases during 2019, 63 cases during 2020, 86 cases during 2021, 53 cases during 2022, 57 cases during 2023 and 23 cases until June 30, 2024.

With regard to the Disciplinary Jurisdiction, until June 30, 2024, the Special Appeal Chamber has registered 21 cases corresponding to this Jurisdiction, of which 2 cases were registered in 2018, 1 case in 2019, 11 cases in 2021, 2 cases in 2022, 4 cases during 2023 and 1 case up to June 30, 2024.

Up to June 30, 2024, the Special Appeal Chamber has rendered a total of 18 decisions corresponding to the Disciplinary Jurisdiction, of which 9 have been final decisions and 9 decisions for non-transference of the case into public hearing.

During the year 2018, the Special Appeal Chamber has announced 2 decisions: 1 final decision and 1 decision for non-transference of the case in public hearing; during 2020, the Special Appeal Chamber has announced 1 final decision; during the year 2021, the Special Appeal Chamber has announced 1 final decision and 3 decisions for non-transference of the case in public hearing; during the year 2022, the Special Appeal Chamber has announced 3 final decisions and 4 decisions for non-transference of the case in public hearing; during the year 2023, the Special Appeal Chamber has announced 3 final decisions and 1 decision for non-transference of the case into public hearing. Until June 30, 2024, the Special Appeal Chamber has not rendered any decision corresponding to the Disciplinary Jurisdiction.
